Meet at Yates Park, Rochester Hills

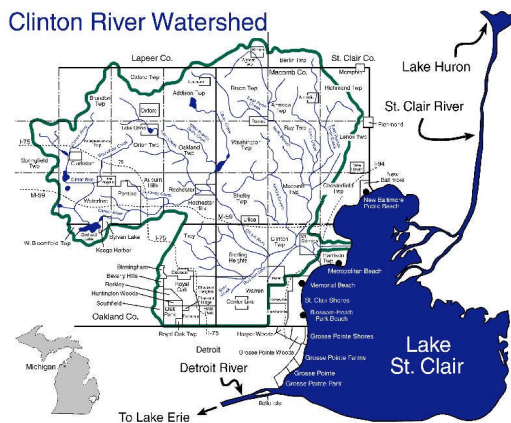
(Northeast of Avon/Dequindre intersection across from Yates Cider Mill)
