Did you know that planting native species can improve the quality of our environment and help keep our water ways clean?

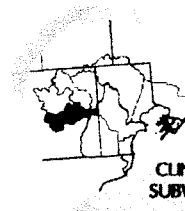
Have you thought about incorporating native plants into your yard and garden? If so, join the Clinton River Watershed Council to learn about various native plants you can incorporate into your landscaping.
